SMoG Intentional Discipleship

Second week of the month:

- ❑ Guys' Discipleship: The goal of guys' discipleship groups is to expose our young men to middle-age and older men who are members of GCPC who are able to teach them to observe all that Christ has commanded, and help foster relationships amongst the group. MS boys are paired with at least one of their Foundations small group leaders and a GCPC member who has been approved to lead a group. HS guys are paired with at least one of their Foundations small group leaders and an older GCPC member who has been approved to lead a group.
- ❑ Ladies' Discipleship: The goal of ladies' discipleship groups is to expose our young ladies to middle-age and older women who are members of GCPC who are able to teach them to observe all that Christ has commanded, and help foster relationships amongst the group. MS girls are paired with at least one of their Foundations small group leaders and a GCPC member who has been approved to lead a group. HS ladies are paired with at least one of their Foundations small group leaders and an older GCPC member who has been approved to lead a group.

SMoG Fellowship Events

Typically the Fourth Weekend of Every Month:

- Home Events: These fellowship events would be designed to provide the youth (both MS and HS) an opportunity to informally fellowship together at a family's home that is willing to host. A different non-home event will be planned for the group that does not have a home fellowship event planned that month.
- Non-Home Events: These fellowship events will typically require a fee to the family (Whirlyball, etc.)
